

Summer Camp Guidelines

Please help us enforce all guidelines by making sure that your group understands and follows them while at Look Up. Willful violation of safety guidelines will result in loss of ALL recreational privileges. Please return this initialed form to Look Up with your reservation deposit.

First-Aid Station

Our First-Aid Station is located down the hallway past the office at the Main Lodge. We stock a variety of first-aid supplies. After hours, please see a summer staff counselor or call either number in your welcome card for assistance.

Rooms

Please do not allow boys inside girls' rooms or girls inside boys' rooms!! Please do not allow your kids to have water, shaving cream and/or graffiti fights inside the rooms. Any damages incurred from these activities will result in a fee of at least \$100.00 plus materials.

Phones

Due to the rise in cell phone use, we no longer have pay phones. There is a phone available for **ADULT EMERGENCY USE ONLY** in the office at the Main Lodge, free of charge.

Vehicles

Please keep your cars, trucks, vans & buses **parked** during your stay. There are simply too many groups here to allow driving. If you need an exception for medical reasons, please see the office manager. Please park your vehicles only in the designated parking spots—Please do not block drives.

Gift Shop

The gift shop (canteen) stocks a variety of snacks, drinks, Look Up Lodge apparel and a variety of other items. If you do not want your group to purchase certain items, you will have to monitor these yourselves. Please come to the gift shop with your meal group.

Coffee

Coffee will be available in the front dining hall at 7:00am for adults only. The entrance to this area is through the lower level Main Lodge Lobby. The door to the serving area will be unlocked **after** the youth have been let in a 8:00am.

Chaperones w/Kids

If you have brought any children ages 3 & under, please be advised that they can **NOT** attend Chapel or Optional Bible Studies.

Clothing

Your group was given specific guidelines on certain inappropriate clothing items in your "Arrival Guidelines" sheet, located in this reservation packet. These guidelines are also posted in your rooms. Please be alert and correct mistakes before leaving your rooms so as to prevent embarrassment and confrontation in front of a larger group. **Remember: Zip-Line & Swing riders MUST wear shorts & t-shirt to ride!!**

Chapel

Food/drinks are **NOT** allowed inside the main chapel. Men's room is downstairs—please go around outside. Also, you will be seated according to meal groups.

Swim Test

This test is not about whether you can swim in a backyard pool; it is critical that you be a **GOOD** swimmer!

Door Person

A summer staff counselor will monitor the entry door at meal times and limit the numbers inside to ensure adequate seating and clean tables. **Please do not allow your kids to unlock the door while summer staff counselor is cleaning tables.**

Sign-ups and paintball ticket purchases will be in the gift shop.

Music

Most of our music is copyrighted. Please do not ask us to make copies.

Smoking

Smoking is **NOT** allowed by youth/children anywhere on campus or by adults inside any buildings.

Horses

Look Up provides pasture to privately owned horses on the back side of camp. Guests are welcome to watch them from behind the fence on the road. **For your safety, absolutely no one is allowed inside the pasture or barn area!!**

Flowers

We have planted beautiful flowers in several places on campus for your enjoyment. Please tell your kids not to pick them so other guests arriving throughout the summer can enjoy them as well.

Air Conditioners

Please do not turn you're a/c any higher than the "8" setting; if you do, it **will** freeze!

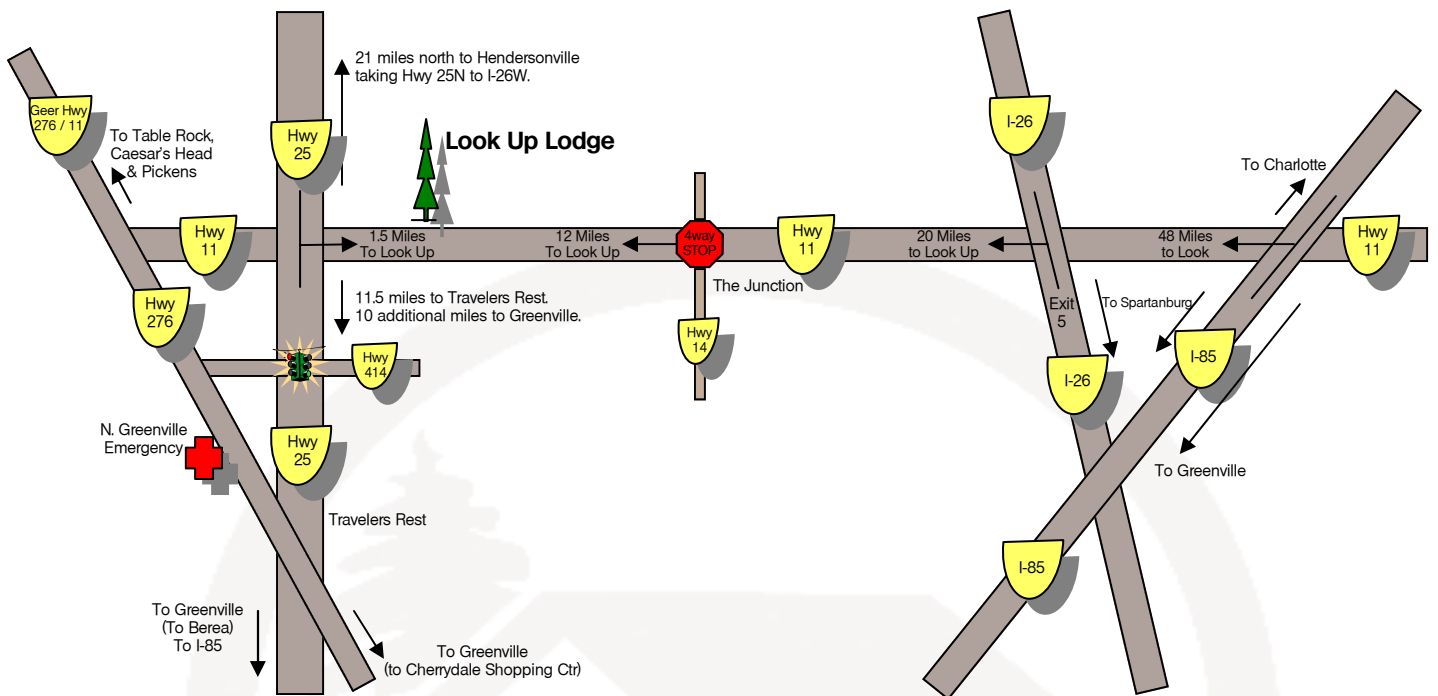

Directions to Look Up Lodge



- From Charlotte, NC**
 Take I-85S to I-26W. Follow I-26W to Hwy 11 (exit 5). Turn left on Hwy 11 (south) and follow for 20 miles. Turn right onto Look Up Lodge Road.
- From Asheville, NC and Hendersonville, NC**
 Take I-26E to Hwy 25S (exit 54). Follow Hwy 25 to Hwy 11 (overpass). Go under the overpass, turn left and go up ramp. Turn right onto Hwy 11. Follow for 1.5 miles. Turn left onto Look Up Lodge Road.
- From Atlanta, GA and Anderson, SC**
 Take I-85N to Hwy 25N (exit 44). Follow Hwy 25 for 27 miles (past Berea, past Furman U., past Travelers Rest) to Hwy 11 (overpass). Turn right and go up ramp. Turn right onto Hwy 11. Follow for 1.5 miles. Turn left onto Look Up Lodge Road.
- From Greenville, SC**
 Take I-385N to N. Pleasantburg Drive (exit 40A). Follow N. Pleasantburg Drive to Wade Hampton Boulevard intersection. Cross Wade Hampton Boulevard intersection (follow signs for N. Pleasantburg Drive) and continue to Hwy 276 (same as Poinsett Hwy) (Cherrydale Shopping Center will be on the left). Turn right onto Hwy 276N (Poinsett Hwy). Follow for 4.7 miles to Hwy 25N exit. Fork right onto Hwy 25N. Follow for 11 miles to Hwy 11 (overpass). Turn right and go up ramp. Turn right onto Hwy 11. Follow for 1.5 miles. Turn left onto Look Up Lodge Road.
- From Columbia, SC**
 Take I-26W to Hwy 11 (exit 5). Turn left on Hwy 11 (south) and follow for 20 miles. Turn right onto Look Up Lodge Road.
- From Knoxville, TN**
 Take I-40E to I-26E (Asheville area). Follow I-26E to Hwy 25S (exit 54). Follow Hwy 25 to Hwy 11 (overpass). Turn left and go up ramp. Turn right onto Hwy 11. Follow for 1.5 miles. Turn left onto Look Up Lodge Road.
