Fort Caswell - Oak Island, NC

Fort Caswell is located on the eastern end of Oak Island, NC, about 35 miles south of Wilmington and just over 70 miles north of Myrtle Beach. Nearby attractions include Southport, Bald Head Island, Battleship NC, and the Fort Fisher Aquarium and State Historic Site.
