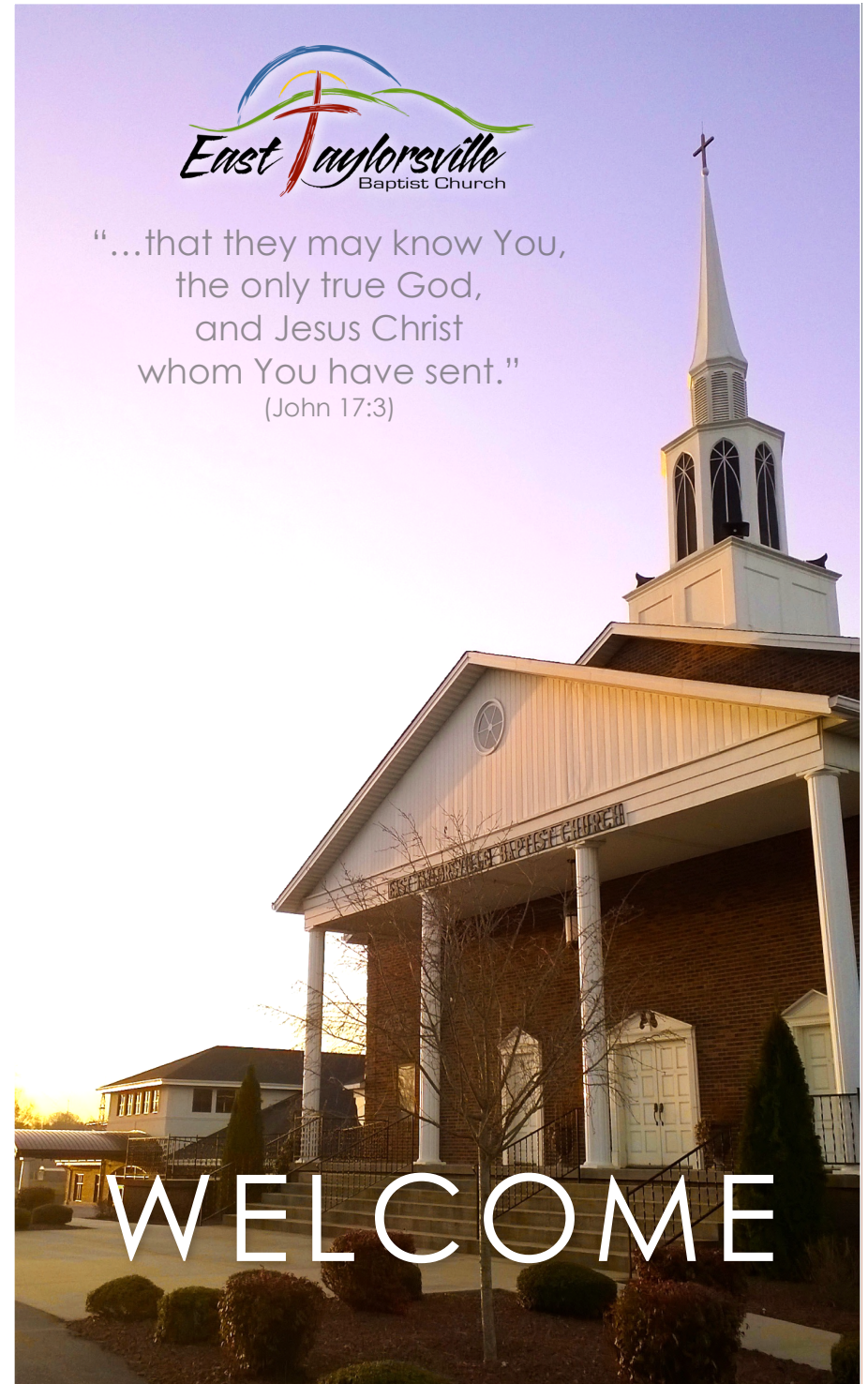

THE MOST IMPORTANT THING

While being involved in a local church is vitally important, it is of greatest importance that we understand our greatest need, a right relationship with God through Jesus Christ. How would you answer these questions?

1. Are you sure you have a right relationship with God?

Consider this...

1. The Bad News: We are all sinners separated from God. (Romans 3:10-12, 23) God is Holy and we have violated His perfect law and will. We are all guilty; deserving punishment.

2. The Worst News: There is nothing we can do to take care of our sin problem. (Romans 6:23, 5:6, 3:19-20) We cannot be good enough, because we always fall short. The penalty is death, separation from God.

3. The Good News: Jesus did for us what we cannot do for ourselves. (Romans 5:8, 1 Peter 3:18) He lived a perfect life, died for our sins, and rose again!

4. The Best News: God's forgiveness and eternal life is a free gift to all who will believe the gospel and repent (John 3:16, Ephesians 2:8-9, Romans 10:9-10).
